i. Correct Growth and Base Fund LAC Probation in the Amount of \$1,000,000.00 for Restorative Justice Programs in Support of Intervention.

Recommendation: Continue funding Conflict Resolution via CBOs. This programming was originally funded through one-time growth funds that have been expended. Conflict Resolution and mediation is needed in all eight institutional facilities to mitigate youth violence and improve the development of youth. Estimated costs \$100,000.00 per camp facility, and \$200,000.00 per hall, totaling \$1,000,000.00 annually.

ii. Fund LAC Commission for Children and Families in the Amount of \$222,418.52 for LAC Youth Commission.

Recommend: Continue funding LAC Youth Commission. The startup funds for this commission were originally funded through one-time growth funds which will be expended by FY 2020-21.
